Professor White gained his PhD in Dermatological Studies from the University of Liverpool and has held a variety of research, education and clinical practice roles. He is currently a part-time Senior Research Fellow in Tissue Viability at Aberdeen Royal Infirmary, with responsibility for clinical research in wound management. Prior to this he held a number of posts within the health industry, all involving links with universities.

Professor White has an impressive publication portfolio of both books and articles, which have focused on detailed scientific perspectives on wound care through to the processes behind a care-focused qualitative approach towards patients. In addition, Professor White is an editorial board member for the British Journal of Nursing, Journal of Lymphoedema, and MIMS Dermatology. He is the Scientific Journal Editor for Wounds UK and the Managing Editor for Wounds UK Books as well as being a reviewer for many nursing and scientific journals and an external expert t assessor for the MHRA (Medical Devices).

In addition to his extensive publications, Professor White is a renowned and inspiring conference presenter and guest lecturer at Universities across the UK and beyond. He is a member of the European Society for Dermatological Research, the British Society for Investigative Dermatology, the Wound Care Society (UK), the Skin Pharmacology Society, the European Tissue Repair Society, the Tissue Viability Society and a council member for the World Union of Wound Healing Societies.
