Mölnlycke Launches 2011 Wound Academy Scholarships

Mölnlycke Health Care has just launched its 2011 Wound Academy scholarships and is encouraging wound care practitioners to apply.

The scholarships provide health care professionals, in the area of wound care, with the opportunity for personal and professional development. Mölnlycke Health Care organises the scholarships as part of its commitment to wound care education.

This year, there will be two categories: Novice Practitioner and Team Award. A Wound Academy panel will select the winners and the awards will be presented at a special ceremony, due to take place in London in October.

A scholarship worth £1,500 is available for the winner of the Novice Practitioner category. There is also the chance for an entrant judged to be 'highly commended' to win a bursary to the Wounds UK annual conference in Harrogate. To enter the Novice Practitioner scholarship, people need to have been in post for less than two years, aspire to a role in tissue viability or spend at least 50 per cent of their time working in a position related to wound care.

The Team Award, worth £1,500, is open to a uni-professional or multi-professional team. The team can be based in either practice or academia and needs to have been established for at least twelve months.

Alison Hedley, Clinical Support Manager at Mölnlycke Health Care, says: "Past winners have benefited enormously from Mölnlycke's assistance and I am keen for wound care practitioners to enter so they can receive our support for their
