

Worcester Leg Club: Local theatre group the St. John's Players has donated a cup in memory of Worcester Leg Club member Fred James who was involved with the amateur acting group. The Leg Club has decided to award the cup to a member or volunteer every six months and it will be engraved with the name of the individual on each occasion.
